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In 2016-2017, Gloucester High School proudly participated in Actua's national pilot program Indigenous STEM (InSTEM). This initiative was founded on a partnership between Actua, the Ottawa-Carleton District School Board and University of Ottawa Engineering, Maker Mobile team. The project enabled Indigenous students to experience STEM through the lens of both Indigenous cultural knowledge, and western science, technology, engineering and mathematics. The goal of the project is to create learning environments where Indigenous students see themselves being successful within the STEM fields of study, also providing cross cultural learning experiences for participating non-Indigenous students.
